## White Wine

- 700 **2008 Pinot Grigio Via Nova, Contri (Italy)**  
*A crisp and characterful version of this Italian classic. This light, slightly spicy white is gently perfumed, showing flavours of fresh peach and lemon with a delicate, dry and nutty finish.*
- 702 **2009 Chenin Blanc, Stormy Cape (South Africa)**  
*Pale in colour with a citrus nose, this is a typically racy South African Chenin with a good concentration of sub tropical fruit well balanced with citrus acidity and a dry finish.*
- 704 **2008 Torrontes, Vinas Riojanas, Famatina Valley (Argentina)**  
*Fragrant and fresh with zesty peachy flavours and a floral finish*
- 706 **2008 Sauvignon Blanc, Wild South, Marlborough (New Zealand)**  
*A fresh and vibrant wine, with citrus, gooseberry and tropical fruit characters. Good depth of flavour with a dry firm finish.*
- 708 **2008 Chardonnay Weighbridge, Peter Lehmann, Barossa (Australia)**  
*Brilliant straw yellow in colour, the nose is freshly picked peaches. The palate is packed with soft fruit, giving a generous middle palate, balanced by a delightfully crisp acidity and long lingering peach flavours.*
- 709 **2009 Pinot Gris Reserve, Santa Florentina, Famatina Valley, Argentina**  
*Pale lemon in colour with greenish tints. A real thirst-quencher with bright citrus and green apple flavours, white floral aromas and hints of spice and lychee. The lovely, fresh acidity balancing the ripe fruit flavours offers a real sense of purity*

## Rosé Wine

- 710 **2008 Rose Sangiovese, Terre Forti Emilia - Romagna (Italy)**  
*A deep coloured Rose with a floral bouquet and light dry flavours of summer fruit*
- 711 **2008 Pinot Grigio Rosé, Monte Vento, Venetie, Italy**  
*A pale salmon pink rose delicate floral aromas and hints of apricot and pear,*

## Red Wine

- 712 **2008 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Umani Ronchi (Italy)**  
*Medium bodied with redcurrant and plummy fruit. It has a good structure and can be enjoyed on its own. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo is one of the most widespread native varieties of Italy, mainly along the Adriatic coast.*
- 714 **2008 Malbec, Amalaya Colome (Argentina 70% Malbec, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Bonarda)**  
*This is a deep red wine. It offers fruity aromas, cherries and raspberries, and a subtle vanilla scent from barrel ageing. A spicy, intense wine, easy to drink, with a long persistent mouth. Tannins are mild and round.*
- 716 **2008 Merlot, De Gras, Colchagua Valley (Chile)**  
*Rich and intensely red with a generously aromatic, ripe nose with blackberry and plum fruit. An attractive balance of fleshy fruit and oak on the palate with notes of mint, velvety tannins.*
- 718 **2008 Shiraz, Heywood, Warburn Estate, South East Australia**  
*Deep purple in colour. The nose shows spicy dark fruit and white pepper. The palate is concentrated and rich with notes of blackcurrant conserve and smoky, stewed plums.*
- 720 **2007 Terre de Lumière, Grenache-Syrah, Vin de Pays d'Oc**  
*This is a ripe but fresh and smooth-textures Grenache-Syrah blend, offering baked-plum flavours and herby savoury depth. With its supple, juicy yet underlying structure, this is a versatile wine, easy to drink on its own or with food*
