- 700 **2019 Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie, (Italy)**
Straw yellow in colour with golden reflexes. The bouquet is ample with floral and fruity notes. The wine is full, pleasant and well-balanced.
- 706 **2019 Sauvignon Blanc, Pale Clouds, Marlborough, New Zealand**
A delightful, fresh Kiwi Sauvignon Blanc from New Zealand's top region for this grape, Marlborough. The wine has a briskness and elegance, but is nonetheless brimful of grassy, lemony freshness with a touch of peach and guava..
- 708 **2019 Chardonnay, Puzzle Ridge (South East Australia)**
Generous aromas of passionfruit & mango, with hints of honeycomb and vanilla oak. The palate is rich and creamy with peach and sweet citrus flavours that lead to a long finish.

- 711 **2019 Pinot Grigio Blush, Belfiore, (Italy)**
A pale salmon pink rosé delicate floral aromas and hints of apricot and pear.
- 339 **2017 White Zinfandel, Adriana, (California)**
A salmon pink rosé wine, with hints of strawberries & raspberries. A medium-sweet style for those who prefer wine not too dry.

Red Wine

- 712 **2018 Cabernet Sauvignon, Altitudes Reserva (Chile)**
An attractive red colour, with hues of purple. Rich berry aromas, with well integrated sweet spices. Medium to full bodied with a good structure and lingering finish.
- 714 **2017 Malbec, Silver Valley, Mendoza (Argentina)**
Deep purplish in colour. Aromas of red and black fruits with hints of floral aromas. The oak provides vanilla, chocolate and roasted coffee in balance with the fruit. The palate is fleshy, with ripe and sweet tannins. Long and elegant finish
- 716 **2016 Merlot Reserva, Gran Araucaria (Chile)**
A fine complex wine with dry fruits, truffle and spice. Its tannins are mellow and soft with a silky after taste.
- 718 **2019 Shiraz, Miranda Estate, South Australia**
This shiraz offers a rich and silky palate with generous fruit flavours balanced by hints of plum with a nuance of chocolate
